Call To Order:

Peter Runyon called the council meeting to order at 10:08 a.m. Because there was not a quorum at that time, there was discussion of other items.

Peter Runyon has invited Eagle County's Environmental Policy Planner Adam Palmer to do a presentation on their ECO Build program for the December council meeting in Minturn.

At 10:17 a.m. a quorum was present.

Approval of Minutes:

M/S/P Karn Stiegelmeier/Tom Clark to approve the minutes of August 23, 2012 meeting as presented. Rob Ittner, Jeff Shroll and David Hook abstained.

Approval of Financials:

M/S/P Tom Clark/Tim Westerberg to approve the list of bills and financials as presented.

Karn Stiegelmeier asked about the Energy Management pub/restaurant lunch and dinner receipts and what NWCCOG's policy is regarding alcohol. Liz responded that weatherization employees are eligible for a per diem, as established by the State of Colorado, when they are on overnight trips. NWCCOG does not allow alcohol purchases on NWCCOG credit cards. Every receipt is checked to ensure that the amounts are within the per diem amount and that alcohol was not purchased.

2011 Independent Audit Report:

David Hook began the discussion on the 2011 independent audit report asking if this timing was fairly typical. Liz reported that NWCCOG's current auditors, Dalby, Wendland & Company had missed deadlines and were not able to finalize the 2011 audit report in time for either the July processes to be supported in the Support of the Suppo

provide a written "management discussion". The auditors had told Liz that such a report was not required. The management discussion does not affect the numbers in the report. There were no negative findings. Dalby, Wendland & Company's three year contract ends this year.

M/S/P Tom Clark/John Hoffmann to accept the 2011 audit report.

Selection of Independent Auditing Firm:

Liz explained that the request for proposal was sent to 15 auditing firms, many of which have experience working with both Councils of Governments and Economic Development Districts. Eight proposals were received. Liz and Mike Kurth reviewed the proposals, held telephone interviews with the top four, and checked references for the top two. Both Mike & Liz recommend Dazzio & Plutt, LLC out of Denver for the following reasons: they are the least expensive; the two principals of the firm will be working with us directly; as a small firm they are able to provide a faster turn- around time between the field work and the final report; they are willing to start preliminary work in November and they have March available for our audit; there are no additional charges if some things take longer than expected; and their prices include the Foundation's 990 and all travel expenses. Dazzio & Plutt have served as the auditors for DRCOG for several years and DRCOG's staff find them easy to work with, thorough, helpful, and able to consistently meet their deadlines. Dazzio & Plutt will also work with NWCCOG's QuickBooks software. Liz asked the Council for permission to accept Dazzio & Plutt's proposal and contract with them for the 2012 audit with the option to renew for the 2013 and 2014 audits.

M/S/P Tom Clark/Tim Westerberg to direct NWCCOG staff to contract with Dazzio & Plutt for the 2012 audit.

Approval of Colorado Health Foundation Grant:

The Alpine Area Agency on Aging (Alpine AAA), through the NWCCOG Foundation, was awarded a one-year grant in the amount of \$65,000 from The Colorado Health Foundation for partnership engagement and consultation costs to facilitate the development of a business plan with partners in the region for an ADRC/ARCH. This grant does not require matching funds. Susan Juergensmeier, Mobility Manager, has confirmed with CDOT that these funds can serve as match for the RTCC's VTCLI and FASTER grants.

The NWCCOG Signature and Authorization Policy (adopted on 10/27/2011) states "Grant Contracts for amounts over \$50,000 must be approved by NWCCOG Council prior to the expenditure of Grant funds but shall be signed by the Executive Director unless otherwise required by the granting agency, consistent with NWCCOG Policies and Procedures."

So NWCCOG staff is asking the Council to approve the acceptance of the Colorado Health Foundation grant award and authorize the executive director to sign the contract on behalf of the NWCCOG Foundation.

Draft 2013 Budget:

Karn Stiegelmeier started the discussion with several clarification questions. They were all answered to the council's satisfaction by Liz Mullen. The only change/addition to the 2013 draft budget was to add cell service to the number one goal in conjunction with the broadband project, (page 33, under Regional Business Program Summary).

Liz reviewed the 2013 draft budget letter from the executive director and fiscal officer, (page 2-3). She pointed out that on 8/23/12 the council was willing to consider staff merit increases and those increases are included in this draft. She also pointed out that the health insurance premium through County Health Pool (CHP) went up 9%, rents charged to programs were increased by 5% to create a reserve for office maintenance and upgrades, and Rural Resort Region (RRR) would be dormant in 2013. Page 3 lays out matching funds for the grant programs, which come out of Regional Business. She also pointed out that \$56,335 will be added to the reserve fund. Liz stated she will add cell phone service to the broadband project narrative. The final 2013 budget will be presented to the Council at the December meeting for approval. There were no other changes or suggestions at this time.

Program Updates:

Liz reviewed the program updates as presented in the meeting materials. Susan Juergensmeier reviewed the update on the Regional Transportation Coordinating Council as presented in the meeting materials.

New Business:

Mark White, Town of Walden, resigned his position as the representative from Walden and from the Executive Committee due to his plans to re-location to the Front Range. He recommended John Hoffmann as his replacement to the executive committee. He also expressed his thanks and best wishes to NWCCOG.

Peter Runyon reminded everyone that the next council meeting will be a face-to-face meeting in Minturn at the Minturn Town Hall on Thursday, 12/6. It will be Peter's last meeting. He also requested that all counties who have new commissioners due to the November election to please attend and bring the newly elected with them.

Liz reminded everyone that the December meeting will also be Jackson County Commissioner John Rich's last meeting due to term limits.

Tim Westerberg stated he will not be able to attend the December Minturn meeting.

2012 Budget Revisions

Attached are the proposed 2012 Budget Revisions.

OVERVIEW: The total budgeted revenue has decreased by \$877,760, but we have made the necessary cuts in expenses to continue to operate within our means. The projected end of year net revenue is expected to increase by only \$27,821 from the original budgeted amount.

Below is a summary of the program specific changes:

Alpine Area Agency on Aging: The revenue numbers reflect the actual reimbursement amounts received for January-October 2012 and projected 4th quarter revenue. The overall budget decreased by \$56,255 from what was revised in July 2012

Energy Management/Weatherization: As Steve Getz presented to the Council at the March 22, 2012 meeting, DOE announced \$0 for Colorado for the 2012 fiscal year. But now additional funding has become available from DOE. The 2012 budget is increased by \$36,977 from what was revised in July 2012.

Elevator Inspection Program: No significant changes.

NW Loan Fund: The revised budget reflects a decrease in funding (\$667,265) available to replenish the NW Revolving Loan Fund, which is also reflected in a decrease in pass through/loans approved. Also due to personnel changes in this program expenses have been drastically reduced. In 2013 we will be working to get the program rebuilt

Regional Transportation Coordinating Council/Rural Resort Region: Due to delays in receiving our grant contracts, this project is getting a late start. This means that less will be spent in 2012. Much of the grant revenue will be pushed into 2013, but the total grant amount for the project remains unchanged and will continue in 2013 and 2014.

Regional Business: Revenue was increased by \$3,468 as a result of one municipal member deciding to join in 2012; other minor adjustments were made to reflect actual activity.

NWCCOG Foundation: Additional grant was received from Colorado Health Foundation.

Indirect/internal services programs: There were minor changes to the copier pool with the installation of a different machine. Also the replacement of a Motor Pool vehicle is being postponed to 2013.

QQ: no changes

External Programs: no changes

The NWCCOG Staff asks the Council to approve the proposed 2012 December budget revisions.

Re: December 2012 Program Updates

The following are the events of note that have occurred since the October 25, 2012 NWCCOG meeting.

Administration/Regional Business

- The new auditing firm, Dazzio & Plutt, LLC, is scheduled to visit NWCCOG on Monday, December 3, 2012 to become familiar with our organization and conduct some preliminary work for the 2012 audit. Field work is scheduled for the first week of March 2013.
- Liz Mullen is scheduled to meet with the Town of Snowmass Village council on December 17, 2012 to discuss NWCCOG's programs and projects.
- NWCCOG has been awarded \$65,000 from DOLA/Energy Mineral Impact Assistance Fund for the Regional Broadband Strategic Plan project in 2013.

Alpine Area Agency on Aging – Jean Hammes, Director

In the October program update, the Alpine AAA reported that it had submitted an application to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment in response to its released Request for Applications (RFA) for the Old Age Pension Dental Program for Fiscal Year 2012-2013. In November the NWCCOG-Alpine Area Agency on Aging was selected as an Old Age pension Dental Assistance provider/administrator. The Old Age Pension Dental Assistance Program assists eligible and qualified low-income seniors (age 60 or older) in obtaining dental services. The initial contract funding is \$50,000 for the project term of December 2012-June 2013.

In November, the Region 12 Long Term Care Ombudsman program sponsored presentations by the Colorado Culture Change Coalition on *Culture Change in Long Term Care Facilities* and on the *Eden Alternative* held at the Whitcomb Terrace Assisted Living Facility and Pitkin County Senior Center in Aspen. The presenters, Penny Cook and Nancy Fox of the Colorado Culture Change Coalition (CCCC) talked about 'what is culture change' and shared the person-centered values of choice, dignity, respect, self-determination, and purposeful living; and helps individuals and organizations develop new ways of thinking, new language, new beliefs, and new behaviors based on a person-centered philosophy of care. The CCCC also provides consumer education about the choices they have when they are in need of care and support for themselves or a loved one. For more information on culture change, the CCCC, or to have presentations brought to your community please contact Jean Hammes.

The Alpine AAA continues to monitor the activity of Congress and the Joint Select Committee on Deficit Reduction, established under the Budget Control Act of 2011, regarding the planned automatic budget cuts under sequestration and other concurrent fiscal possibilities in 2013. In addition, the Older American

Act has still not been reauthorized and the aging network is paying attention to any discussion and efforts regarding its reauthorization and appropriations for the Administration on Aging.

Economic Development District – Rachel Lunney, Communications and Research Manager

Next Colorado Blueprint Region 12 Meeting on December 11th in Vail

The next Region 12 Colorado Blueprint meeting will be held on Tuesday, Dec. 11th from 11 am - 2 pm at Vail Town Hall. All NWCCOG council members, town managers, elected officials, key staff, and economic development stakeholders from the region are invited to attend. The draft Region 12 Strategic Summary, which will be incorporated into the Colorado Blueprint (Statewide economic development strategic plan) will be reviewed. Also, there will be discussion on aligning the Colorado Blueprint Region 12 Strategic Summary with NWCCOG EDD 2013 Scope of Work.

NWCCOG Selected to Receive Free Technical Assistance Workshop from Smart Growth America in 2013

NWCCOG has been selected to receive a free workshop in 2013 as part of Smart Growth America's free technical assistance program. Smart Growth America is committed to providing the tools and training to help community leaders keep their cities and towns livable, sustainable, and economically prosperous places. This program is funded through a grant from U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Office of Sustainable Communities under its Building Blocks for Sustainable Communities Program. The Building Blocks program funds quick, targeted assistance to communities that face common development problems. Each year, Smart Growth America makes a limited number of technical assistance workshops available to interested communities for zero cost. This competitive award gives communities a chance to understand the technical aspects of smart growth development through a one- or two-day workshop on a subject of their choosing. NWCCOG's workshop will be on the tool: Planning for Economic and Fiscal Health. This workshop will draw on successful private and public sector lessons to help local leaders foster smart growth communities that cost taxpayers less to build, run and maintain. It will provide the latest lessons in how smart growth saves money for local governments, makes money for businesses, and is integral for the long-term fiscal and economic health of the community. The date for the workshop is to be determined. NWCCOG will invite a wide variety of community members to this free workshop once the date and details have been determined.

Elevator Inspection Program (EIP) — Gene Morse, Director

The elevator inspectors are very busy, which is typical for this time of year, as everyone is working to complete construction projects for the upcoming ski season.

Energy Management (Weatherization) – Steve Getz, Director

On October 10th Energy Management Director Steve Getz and Field Supervisor Doug Jones participated in an all-day conference on the new Weatherization Field Guide being developed by the Colorado Energy Office (CEO). The meeting was held at the offices of Arapahoe County Weatherization in Aurora Colorado. Agencies from across Colorado met to discuss the requirements and content of the Field Guide, which is intended to be a quick-reference guide for field personnel in the Weatherization Assistance Program. The original draft was posted online as a PDF so that agencies could make initial comments prior to the meeting. After the meeting was held on October 10th another draft was posted for further comment that was due in early November. An outside consultant has been hired by CEO to write the drafts, take and incorporate comments, and then publish the final version after all editing and comments. The Field Guide is scheduled to be published in December 2012.

Steve Getz and Doug Jones then returned October 11th for an all-day session about ASHRAE 62.2. Many years ago ASHRAE (American Society for Heating Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers) developed a standard related to the ventilation of tightly-built new-construction homes. More recently this standard has been updated and it is now the intention of ASHRAE that their new standard also be extended to include existing homes being retrofitted for energy efficiency. Despite the high cost of these installations, and the seeming paradox of working to air-seal and tighten an existing home followed by the installation of exhaust fans, the Department of Energy has adopted 62.2 and is pushing states to fully implement the new requirements. Colorado has adopted a phased-in approach, and local agencies this year are installing ventilation fans in a small percentage of all homes weatherized. For July, August and September 2012, CEO only required that 10% of all homes weatherized receive exhaust fans meeting the ventilation requirement. CEO is requiring that 25% of all homes weatherized between January 1st 2013 and March 31st 2013 receive a ventilation fan and meet the requirements of ASHRAE 62.2, and is requiring full adoption by July 1 2013. The purpose of this meeting was to share technological problems and solutions between Colorado's local agencies, and the meeting was helpful in exchanging tips and ideas about wholesale outlets that sell the fans, various issues with Building Departments experienced at different locations throughout the state, etc. Another follow-up meeting will be held in April or May of 2013 as is it CEO's expectation that all homes weatherization after July 1 2013 will meet the ventilation requirements of ASHRAE 62.2.

Northwest All Hazards Emergency Management Region (NWAHEMR) – Christy Laney,

Homeland Security Coordinator

The NWAHEMR Steering Committee met in Fraser on November 21, 2012. The 2012 State Homeland Security Grant contract has been executed and the following projects will be funded through this grant: Final phase of the Public Works radio purchases, Public Works DTR Exercise, HazMat ID Software Upgrade for the five Hazmat Teams in the region, Bomb Certification Training for a new member of the Grand Junction Bomb Squad, IT Equipment for the Vail EOC. The NWAHEMR will begin accepting project proposals for the 2013 SHSG, although grant guidance is not yet available.

Northwest Loan Fund (NLF)

NWCCOG staff has had some success in collecting on past-due loans for the NLF (approx. \$130,000 to date). The NLF shows a total of \$302,613 in defaulted loans dating back as far as 10 years to businesses that have dissolved or are no longer at the address we have on file, therefore our attempts to contact them have failed. These loans will likely be written off at the end of this year. Currently there are nine active loans totaling \$257,870, most of which are current with their payments. Monthly payments provide approximately \$2,738 per month in income.

Rural Resort Region (RRR)/ Regional Transportation Coordinating Council (RTCC) - Susan

Juergensmeier, Mobility Manager

The transportation providers are meeting on December 3, 2012 to discuss the logistics of the One Call/One Click center. The next RTCC meeting is scheduled for December 5, 2012.

Watershed Services and Water Quality and Quantity Committee (QQ) -

Lane Wyatt and Shanna Koenig, Co-Directors

1.) QQ Board Meeting was held on October 31st. The group discussed possibilities of working with NWCCOG to identify wildfire mitigation funding opportunities and ensure watershed protection is included in forest management discussions and decisions. Representatives from QQ, NWCCOG and CBBC are meeting on Wednesday, November 28th to discuss how the organizations can work together on this issue.

- 2.) QQ is a party to the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission rulemakings regarding setbacks and water sampling and monitoring.
- 3.) QQ participated in a conference call establishing a Water Efficiency Action Network for the Colorado River Basin. QQ has been asked to sit on the steering committee.
